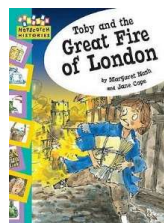
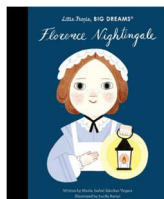
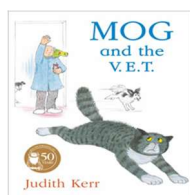


Class 1 Y1 and Y2 Summer 1

Key Learning this term...

Our Y1 and Y2 topic this term is 'People Who Help Us'. We are looking forward to learning about the role of nurses, vets, firefighters, and police officers in the past and present.

In English our year 1 children will continue to work on correctly sized handwriting, learn to spell words with the prefix 'un', consolidate their understanding of how to punctuate different types of sentences and use the contraction 'and'. Our year 2 children will practise pre-cursive handwriting and focus on spelling rules for adding the suffixes 'ly', 'ful' and 'less'. They will write in the present and past tense and consolidate their understanding of statements, commands, questions and exclamations.

In Maths we will learn about fractions, money and time.

In History we will be learning about the work and lives of Florence Nightingale and Samuel Pepys. We will also find out about The Great Fire of London.

In PSHE lessons we will explore ways of staying safe both at home and when we are 'out and about'.

In science we will continue to discover more about materials and their properties. We will have fun creating an ideal home for the 'Three Little Pigs' as we learn about properties of a range of materials.

In Art we will explore colour mixing, making secondary colours and using them in a range of art activities. In D+T we will learn about structures as we make a pencil pot.

In RE lessons, we will learn about what Christians believe and how Christian stories provide guidance.
