Mental Health & Wellbeing - Nurturing school ethos. - Highly trained staff provide ELSA support (1:1) for identified children. - Small Nurture group, run by trained and experienced staff, for identified children. - Progressive PSHE and RSE curriculums - Reflection area in all classrooms. - Mental Health First Aider for staff, along with access to high quality counselling and support via dedicated e-mail. - Circle Time within in each class, providing a safe and structured space.
