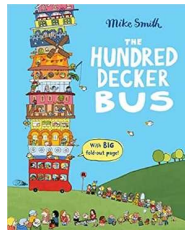
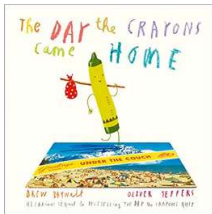


Class 1 Y1 and Y2 Spring 2

Our class texts...



Key Learning this term...

Our Y1 and Y2 topic this term is 'Travel and Transport'.

Whilst enjoying reading our fabulous texts, Y2s will learn more about conjunctions (when, because, if, that) and explore different sentence types (statements, exclamations and questions). Y1s will focus on recording simple sentences and applying their growing knowledge of phonics.

In science we will learn about properties of a range of materials. We will plan and carry out exciting tests to discover more about 'floating and sinking' and 'waterproofing'.

In history we will learn about how transport has changed over time.

We will learn the names of the four countries that make up 'The United Kingdom' and their capital cities in geography.

In D+T we will explore 'wheel and axle' mechanisms as we design and make a simple 'pull along' toy.

In maths lessons, Y2s will learn about multiplication and division (linked to the 2, 5 and 10 times tables) and length/height using standard units of measure (cm and m). Y1s will learn about place value to 50, addition and subtraction (using numbers to 20) and length/height using non standard units of measure.

We will consider 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?' in RE.
