Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'Wonderful Women from history'. We will learn about women who have made history, such as Rosa Parks, Emmeline Pankhurst and Greta Thunberg.

In Year 1 phonics we will continue to use 'Little Wandle' to learn more alternative spellings for sounds we already know. Your child will receive their new reading book on Fridays. Please encourage your child to read at home with you at least 3 times a week. Year 2s will learn about rules for when we add the word endings ing/er/est/y/ed and revisit apostrophes for possession and contractions.

In **writing** we will be continuing to practice writing accurate sentences, applying our learning when making posters and writing biographies and fact files.

In **maths**, Y1s and Y2s will learn about time, position and direction and revisit fractions.

In **geography** we will be learning about human and physical geography and developing our fieldwork skills. In **history** we will learn about the lives of the wonderful women who helped change the world.

In **art** we will be learning craft techniques to design maps. In **music** we will be developing our musical skills and knowledge.

In **computing** we will be programming quizzes.

In **PE** we will be learning orienteering skills.

In **PSHE** we will be learning about 'Bullying' and in **RE** we will be learning about why we should care for the world, reflecting on Christian and Muslim beliefs/stories.

Reminders...

Please make sure your child brings their bag to school every day, with their reading book.

A new reading book will be given out each Friday and children will also choose a book from our class library. Please provide your child with a filled water bottle each day. We encourage children to drink water.

PE kits should be in school at all times. Our specific PE day will be on a Monday this term. PE kits will come home at the end of the half term for a wash.
