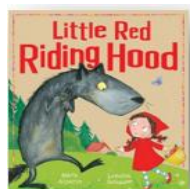

Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'Fairytales!'

In Year 1 phonics lessons, children will continue to learn lots of new phase 5 sounds and read and spell words with these sounds. In Year 2 spelling sessions, we will learn and apply spelling rules (see weekly homework). Your child will continue to receive their new Little Wandle decodable reading book and their chosen reading for pleasure book every Friday. Please encourage your child to read at home with you, 3 x per week.

During literacy, we will be looking at traditional fairytales. We will enjoy writing stories and innovating our own endings!

In maths, Year 1s will be practicing adding and subtracting numbers within 20. Year 2s will be learning about multiplication and division, linked to the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Both year groups will be exploring length, height, mass and capacity.

In geography we will be reading and making simple maps and in science we will be learning about living things and their habitats, looking at habitats around the world.

We will be making Mother's Day and Easter crafts in art lessons and in DT, we will be designing and making Baby Bear's chair!

In Music, we will explore different sound sources and in PE we will learn basis tennis skills.

We will explore data handling during computing lessons and learn how to create pictograms!

In RE we will be learning about what makes some places sacred.
