Key Learning this term...

This term our topic is 'Space!'

In phonics, Y1s will continue to learn lots of new phase 5 sounds. Y2s will be beginning to learn some more complex spelling rules using the Little Wandle spelling scheme.

In Writing we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will enjoy writing stories, instructions and non-chronological reports!

In Maths, Year 1's will be learning about addition and subtraction within 20. Year 2's will be learning about money as well as multiplication and division.

We will be carrying out a local traffic survey in Geography and in History we will be comparing Neil Armstrong to Tim Peake! In Science we will be learning about living things and their habitats.

Y1s and Y2s will explore patterns and colour mixing in Art and Design and make a model fairground wheel in D+T! In Music, we will be learning about lots of different styles of music, focusing on the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch.

We will be learning how to program a robot using different algorithms in Computing! The focus for PE will be gymnastics – performing simple sequences using a range of movements.

In PSHE we will explore 'emotions' and in RE we will discover more about what Muslims believe.
