EYFS

1. Please read your reading book with an adult and revisit last term's sounds (see yellow home book).
2. Design a snowman (see worksheet for ideas). Don't worry if you haven't got a printer. If you have a piece of white paper, you could use any craft materials to decorate a snowman.
3. Draw a number track from 0 to 10. Find objects to count sets up to 10 (e.g. buttons, pasta pieces, toys etc..) Counts sets of objects. Can you find the number on the number track? Can you find one more than a number?

Y1s and Y2s

1. Read your school reading book for at least 10 minutes – ask a grown up to sign your reading record if possible.
