Key Learning this term...

This term our Y1s and Y2s topic is 'Magic and Mystery'.

In English, we will read exciting stories about 'Ghosts' and 'witches'. We will write character and setting descriptions and stories whilst learning to write different types of sentences (statements, questions and exclamations).

In science we will explore 'Growth', learning about human and other animal life cycles.

In maths we will learn about addition and subtraction (to 10 - y1s/to 100 - y2s) and discover more about 2d and 3d shapes (shape names and properties). Please refer to the maths homework to see how you can help your child.

In history, we will focus on important events that we celebrate (Gunpowder Plot and Remembrance Sunday). We will consider how and why we celebrate these important events. We will also discover more about Christmas during Victorian times.

In RE lessons, we will be thinking about different faith communities. Our PSED topic is 'Responsibility' and we will explore British Values.

In D+T we will explore joining techniques as we sew simple pouches.

Our PE focus is 'dance' and our music focus will be learning and performing songs for our nativity performance.

Reminders...

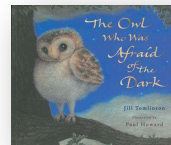
Please make sure your child brings their bag to school every day, with their reading book. A new reading book will be given out each Friday and children will also choose a book from our class library
