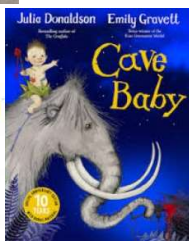
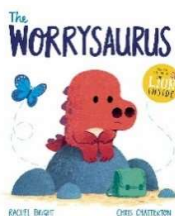
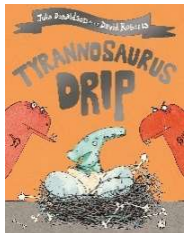

Key Learning this term...

Welcome back to class 1. This term Y1s and Y2s are learning all about 'Dinosaurs' and 'Keeping healthy'.

In science and PSHE we will learn about animals (including humans) needs for survival. We will also explore ways of staying healthy (healthy eating, rest, keeping clean and exercise).

In maths, we will learn about place value, reading and ordering numbers and addition and subtraction.

Our fantastic literacy texts this term are focussed around the theme of Dinosaurs. We will read and write stories, poems and information texts about dinosaurs whilst we learn how to record and punctuate simple sentences.

In art, we will explore line, shape and texture. Using a range of drawing materials, we will draw familiar objects.

In D+T, we will explore simple mechanisms (a pivot, lever and linkages) to help us make a moving dinosaur head.

In RE lessons, we will consider 'Who is God?'.

Our PE focus is 'attack, defend and shoot'. We will learn to dribble, stop and bounce a ball with skill.
