Key Learning this term...

This term's learning is based around 'Under the Sea'. We will be thinking of beach holidays and sunny get-aways, as well as pirates and sea life!

In **Maths** this term we will be consolidating our understanding of number, as well as spending time learning about sorting, shape, measures and time.

In **Literacy** we will be reading the texts on the left and producing longer pieces of writing inspired by them and reading poetry. We are continuing to develop our letter formation and will be continuing our Little Wandle reading session three times a week.

In some of our other topic areas we are:

- riding the balance bikes on a course and trying to keep our balance whilst lifting our feet to go faster. We are learning to steer with accuracy and use the brake to slow down.
- practising controlling and moving objects like balls and recognising the difference between actions such as moving softly, powerfully.
- relating body movements to music.
- developing a sense of beat, playing instruments by shaking, tapping and scraping.
- using running stitch to make a simple teddy bear.
- planning and evaluating when we create.
- retelling a story and talking about non-fiction books or poems to friends and adults.
- designing and making our own number games that incorporates subitising (recognising amounts without counting) and number bonds.
