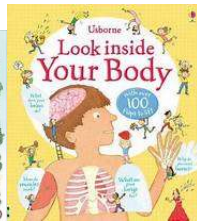
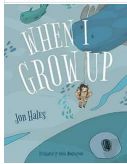
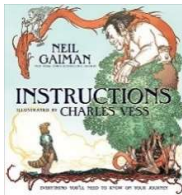


Class 1 Y1 and Y2 Summer 2

Key Learning this term...

Our Y1 and Y2 topic is 'All About Me'.

In science we will learn about parts of the body and what they are used for. We will plan and carry out exciting tests linked to our senses.

In geography we will learn about human and physical features of Churchtown and we'll go on a visit around Churchtown to explore these features further.

Our fantastic class stories ('A Child of Books' and 'The Pencil') will inspire us to write our own imaginative stories. We will also practise writing instructions, linked to making a healthy dessert. The children will enjoy reciting classic performance poetry by poet AA Milne and create their own verses for the poem.

In PE, we will practise skills linked to sending and receiving' equipment.

In RE lessons, we will listen and recall important bible stories ('Matthew the Tax Collector' and 'The Lost Son'). Children will explore what these stories mean to Christians.

In maths lessons, Y2s and Y1s will learn about time, position, direction and statistics. Y2s will continue to practise multiplication and division facts linked to the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
