Key Learning this term...

This term our EYFS children are learning all about 'All Creatures Great and Small'. Children will learn about pets and farm animals and we will experience looking after some eggs which will hopefully hatch into chickens!

We will write simple sentences linked to our books and record information sentences about our chicken visitors. In phonics, we will consolidate our learning of the letter sounds to match diagraphs (ai ee igh oa oo or ar or ur ow oi ear air er) and practise reading and spelling words with these sounds in them, including some longer words.

In maths, we will practise making 10 using 2 numbers e.g. $8 + 2$ $7 + 3$ (supported by a variety of equipment). Children will learn about subtraction by taking away a number from 10 and counting the remainder. They will also learn to continue, copy and create simple patterns using shapes.

The children will discover more about Spring and the Christian celebration of Easter.

There will be plenty of opportunities to be creative! Children will explore being a dog groomer and a pet shop owner as well as experience colour mixing, making a fabric collage and creating homes for our pets.
