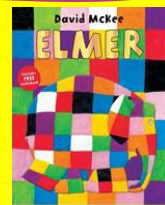
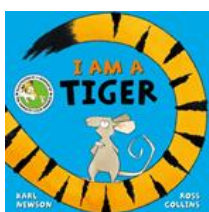
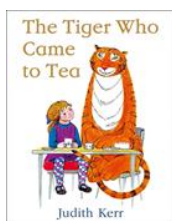

Key Learning this term...

Jump on board a jeep, as our EYFS children go on safari! We will have lots of fun learning about African animals as we roleplay being a tourist!

Children will compare and discuss the similarities and differences between their lives and the lives of others in a contrasting part of the world. They will learn about the similarities and differences between the natural world around them and a contrasting locality (Africa).

Children will study some fabulous story and information books about animals around the world and practise applying their growing knowledge of phonics as they write words and sentences for different purposes e.g. lists, invitations, simple stories. We will continue to encourage children to use correctly formed letters and hold their writing equipment with a correct grip.

In maths, we will practise adding by counting on and subtracting by counting back, working with numbers up to 20. We will learn to double numbers (up to $5 + 5$) and find half of even numbers (up to 10), through practical activities.
