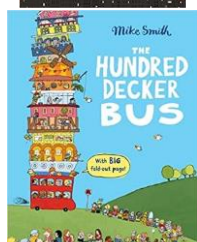
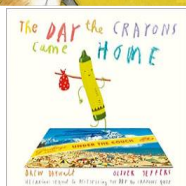




Newsletter Y1 and Y2 Summer Term 1 2023

Key Learning this term...

Our Y1 and Y2 topic this term is 'Travel and Transport'.

In science, we will learn about the properties of a range of materials. We will plan and carry out an exciting test to find out about aeroplane flight as we discover 'Which paper aeroplane will go the furthest?'.

In history, we will learn about how transport has changed over time and the first aeroplane flight, made by the Wright brothers.

We will learn the names of the four countries that make up 'The United Kingdom' and features of these countries in geography. We will also research the capital cities and discover human and physical features of these cities.

In D+T we will study a simple 'wheel and axle' mechanism as we design and make a model 'Ferris wheel' suitable to view the sights of one of our capital cities.

Our fantastic class texts ('Meerkat Mail' and 'The Day the Crayons Came Home') will help us learn about the features of postcards, letters, emails and texts. We will also explore imaginary and factual recounts linked to our class trip (details to follow).

In RE lessons, we will consider why Christian and Jewish people think it is important to care for others and the world and how this affects how they live their lives.
