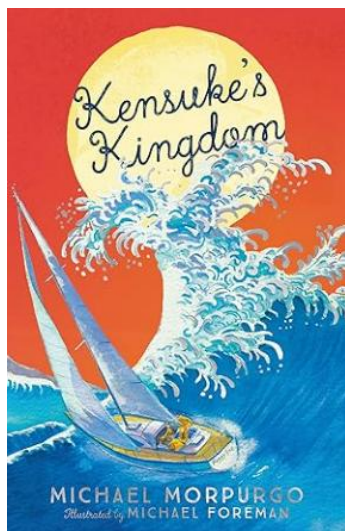

Key Learning this term...

Our literacy this half term will be based around Michael Morpurgo's modern classic *Kensuke's Kingdom* - a fantastic story of a young boy's journey around the world in a small boat.

In maths we will be learning about statistics and geometry. We will finish the year by reviewing topics studied previously to ensure the children are well prepared for the next stage of their education as they move to year 4 or year 5.

In science we will be focusing on scientific enquiry skills such as fair testing, using controls and taking accurate measurements.

Our computing lessons will once again look at programming and we will be continuing to study French. In RE we will be considering the question 'How and why do people try to make the world a better place?' from a range of religious and non-religious perspectives. In PSHE lessons will be learning how we can keep ourselves safe both physically and mentally in real world and online environments.

In PE we will be focusing on athletics as we prepare for Summer events such as South Peak and sports day.

Vision and values

Our value this half term is 'respect' and we will be exploring this through collective worship and our PSHE lessons. We are continuing to hold regular 'circle time' sessions as part of these lessons to give children the chance to explore and express their feelings.
