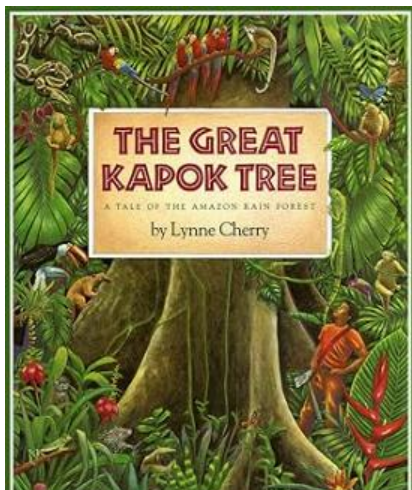

Key Learning this term...

In Maths this term we will be learning about fractions. Year 3s will be working on finding equivalent fractions before moving on to adding and subtracting fractions; Year 4s will be simplifying fractions and adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers.

In literacy we will be considering environmental themes through a range of texts. We will be beginning with The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry before moving on to look at other books with a similar message.

In science, we will be investigating forces and magnets. This will also help with our DT project, where we will be making slingshot cars. In geography, we will be learning about volcanoes and earthquakes. In RE, we will be learning about celebrations in Judaism and in computing we will be exploring branching databases.

Swimming has now finished so the focus for our PE lessons on a Wednesday afternoon will switch to handball and team building activities.
