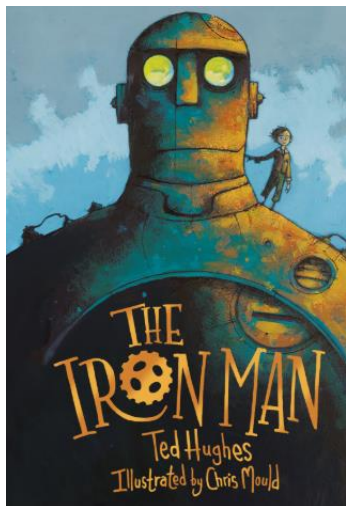

Key Learning this term...

This half term we will be reading Ted Hughes' modern classic, *The Iron Man*, and using this as the basis for much of our writing. In maths, we will be focusing on multiplication and division. We are working particularly hard on our times tables at the moment so any extra help with this from home is appreciated.

Our science topic for the half term is animals including humans. This covers nutrition, which we are also thinking about in DT, and muscles and skeletons. In religious education we will be learning about Hinduism. In geography we are looking at countries and continents. In PSHE we will be learning about and reflecting on money and in computing we will be learning about stop motion animations and creating our own projects.

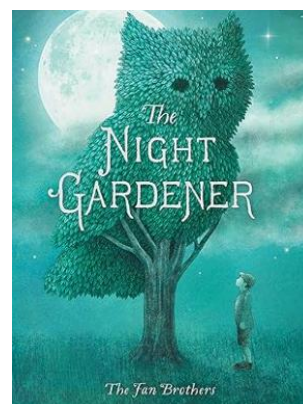
Reminders...
