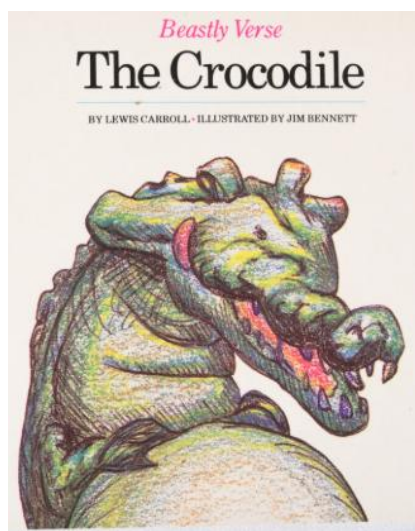

Key Learning this term...

We're starting our literacy this half term by continuing with the text we started after Easter, *The Wild Robot* by Peter Brown. Once we've completed this, we'll finish the year with some poetry, including Lewis Carroll's *The Crocodile*.

The wild theme extends into other activities. In science we will be learning about living things and their habitats, we also have forest school and - of course - the activity day and sleepover.

In maths we are currently completing a unit on time and will then move on to learning about angles and properties of shapes, followed by money and statistics. Year 4s also have a unit to cover on position and direction, giving Year 3s a chance to revisit some previously taught content.

Times tables

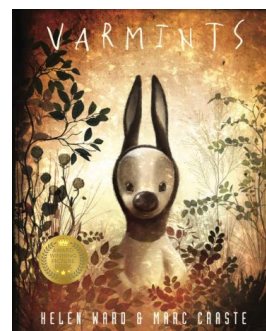
Next week our Year 4 pupils will be sitting their multiplication tables check. This is an online quiz of all times tables up to 12×12 with 25 questions and 6 seconds per answer. We've been working hard on these all year so we know everyone is ready but if there are any last minute multiples that are struggling to stay in the brain then now is the time to get in some last minute practice. There's no pass mark for this so the aim is full marks - 25 out of 25! For Year 3 - it's your turn next year so keep learning those tables.
