Key Learning this term...

This half term we will be using Peter Brown's *The Wild Robot* as the basis for our literacy lessons. We'll read the whole book and take inspiration from the story in our writing.

In maths, we will be learning about time and money, including decimals for Year 4. We will then move on to look at angles and properties of shape.

Our science topic is electricity and we will be putting our learning into practice through our design technology lessons, which focus on creating torches.

We will also be looking at rivers in our geography lessons, photo editing in computing, Hinduism in religious education and food in our French lessons. Our PSHE topic is relationships, which is often helpful to consider as we move towards the transition to the next school year.

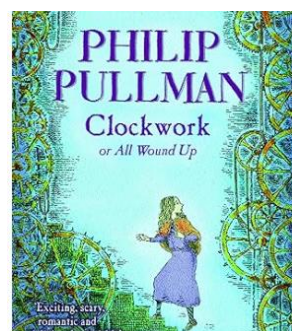
We are now offering breakfast club free for all children from 8am each day as part of a Department for Education funded pilot. Please sign up on Parent Pay if you'd like a place.

Reminders...

Homework is set every Wednesday and due back the following week. Children are given a literacy worksheet to complete and are also asked to spend time on Maths Whizz at home to earn at least two blue gems and one red gem.

We also ask children to read to an adult at home three times a week - as they do in school - and have their reading records signed. It's also a great idea to practice times tables. We have a test every Friday and Year 4 children will be sitting their multiplication tables check later this term.
