Key Learning this term...

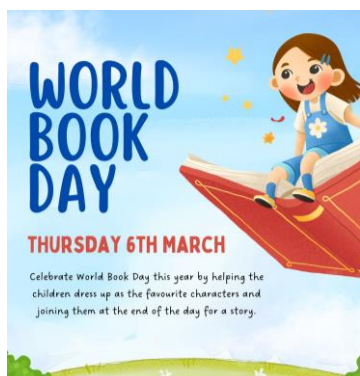
Our literacy this term will be based around Roald Dahl's fantastic story, *The BFG*. We'll be using this as the inspiration for our writing as well as reading the story in class.

In maths, we will be spending most of the half term learning about fractions. Year 4 will then be moving on to look at decimals while Year 3 focus on mass, capacity and volume.

Science this half term could get loud as we learn about sound - what it is, how it travels and how we hear. We will also be continuing to learn about the history of England - moving on from the Anglo Saxons and Vikings to the Normans.

In design technology we'll be investigating structures and building a model pavilion. As we move towards Easter, we'll also be learning about the events of Holy Week and thinking about what kind of World Jesus wanted.

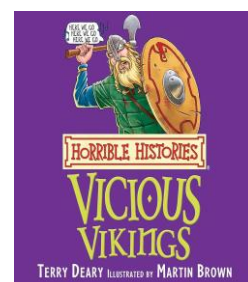
World Book Day is next Thursday (6th March). Children can attend school dressed as their favourite book character and we're inviting parents to join us at the end of the day to share a story with their children.

Reminders...

Homework is set every Wednesday and due back the following week. Children are given a literacy worksheet to complete and are also asked to spend time on Maths Whizz at home to earn at least two blue gems and one red gem.

We also ask children to read to an adult at home three times a week - as they do in school - and have their reading records signed. It's also a great idea to practice times tables. We have a test every Friday and Year 4 children will be sitting their multiplication tables check in the Summer term.
