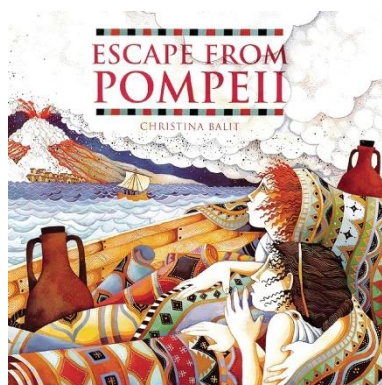

Key Learning this term...

This half term we will be learning about the Romans in history and also studying volcanoes and earthquakes in geography. These two subjects will combine when we focus on the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79AD and the consequences of this for the Roman city of Pompeii.

In maths we will be learning about statistics and geometry. We will finish the year by reviewing topics studied previously to ensure the children are well prepared for the next stage of their education as they move to year 4 or year 5.

In science we will be focusing on scientific enquiry skills such as fair testing, using controls and taking accurate measurements.

Our computing lessons will once again look at programming and we will be continuing to study French. In RE we will be looking at different Christian values and our PSHE lessons will consider how we can keep ourselves safe.

Our music partnership lessons will finish with a concert on 1 July, to which parents are invited, and we are carrying on with swimming for the next four weeks.

Vision and values

Our value this half term is 'respect' and we will be exploring this through collective worship and our PSHE lessons. We are continuing to hold regular 'circle time' sessions as part of these lessons to give children the chance to explore and express their feelings.
