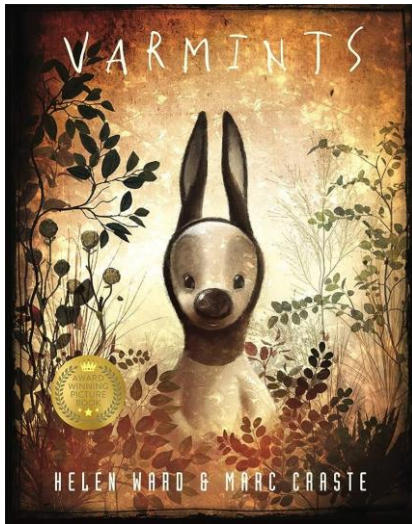

Key Learning this term...

In Maths this term we will be continuing to learn about fractions. Year 3s will be working on finding equivalent fractions before moving on to adding and subtracting fractions; Year 4s will be simplifying fractions and adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers.

In literacy we will be considering environmental themes through a range of texts. We will be beginning with a picture book that hides a serious message - Varmints by Helen Ward - and then exploring similar topics through The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry and The Hidden Forest by Jeannie Baker.

In science, we will be celebrating the arrival of Spring with a topic on plants. We'll be investigating what affects plant growth and learning about processes including photosynthesis and pollination.

Other subjects will continue as last half term with the exception of PE, which will switch from hockey to tennis - in addition to swimming which continues on Wednesday afternoons.

Vision and values

Our value this half term is 'forgiveness' and we will be exploring this through our daily worship and RE lessons, linking the theme to the Easter Story.

Our Easter Service will be on the last day of term - 28th March - at 10am at St Helen's. All are welcome, as always.
