Key Learning this term...



This term, Class 2 are kicking off the year with our Mighty Metals topic!

In Literacy, we will be reading the Iron Man by Ted Hughes and exploring the adventures of the magical, metal giant. This will include writing for different purposes such as character descriptions, poetry and letters.

In Science, we will be learning about magnets and exploring magnetic materials through class investigations.

In Maths, we will be looking at place value, rounding and looking at various strategies to help us with addition and subtraction. We will also be applying our knowledge to reasoning and problem-solving tasks to deepen our learning.

In Art & DT we will be learning about Klimt, making our own portraits and foil sculptures.

In Geography, we will be exploring the world, discovering how mountains are formed and where you can find the highest ones.

In our PE lessons, we will be playing tag rugby to prepare us for the competition at the end of the half term. In RE, we will be looking at the creation story, and in PSHE, exploring relationships.
