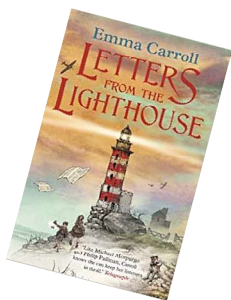

Key Learning this term...
