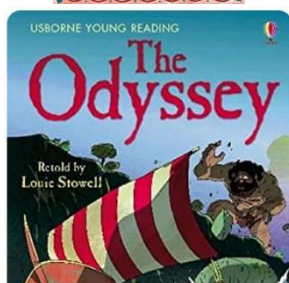
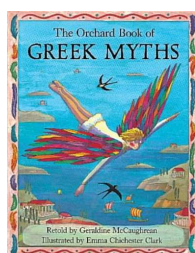

Key Learning this term...

Literacy: We will be learning about the Ancient Greeks in History this term and this will also be the focus for our Literacy lessons. The children will be writing information texts, blogging and writing a myth. Our poetry this term will be based on *The Tyger* by William Blake.

Maths: We will be moving onto multiplication and division, and fractions.

Geography: We will be looking at mountains around the world and their features.

Science: Our topic this term will be properties of materials.

DT: Is cooking this term and we will be developing a recipe for spaghetti bolognese.

Art: We will be painting self portraits!

PE: We have a sports coach coming into school to teach gymnastics on a Thursday afternoon.

PSHE: We will be learning all about money matters.

Spelling test: We will be giving out weekly spelling lists on Monday and will test on a Friday Morning.
