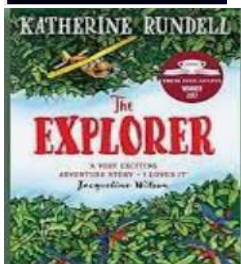
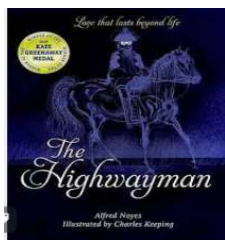

Key Learning this term...

This term, Churchtown will be reflecting on the value of **thankfulness** in classrooms and in Collective worship.

Literacy: We will be debating and writing a balanced argument about whether we should be able to tell the Brazilian government how best to tackle rainforest deforestation; writing a newspaper and an information text. All of our work will relate to our class book: The Explorer by Katherine Rundell. We will also be studying The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes for this term's poetry focus.
