Our class texts...



Key Learning this term...

This term Year 5 and 6 are learning about The War Years, our topic will focus on WW2.

Our literacy lessons this term will stem from a number of war time texts such as 'The Valley of Lost Secrets', 'Anne Frank's Diary' and 'The Ruined City of Kor'. We will use these texts as a stimulus for writing a History story and a number of diary entries. We will teach grammar principles daily and the children will read a wide variety of books during their guided reading sessions and establish links between texts.

In Maths we are focusing on building upon the link between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will consolidate our arithmetic learning through short fluency sessions. We are focusing on problem solving this term and the children will be given time to answer a wide range of problem-solving questions from a variety of mathematical areas.

In History we will explore different aspects of the war e.g., the Home Front, Evacuees, Propaganda and The Blitz.

Our PSHE sessions will focus upon making good choices and how to stay safe online. In RE we are focusing on incarnation.

In science we will be looking at light. In DT we will use spaghetti to build a bridge!

Thursday 12th December: Christmas jumper day and Christmas craft afternoon

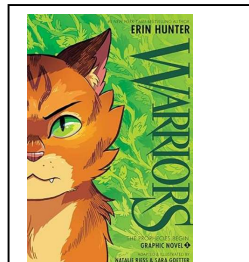
Friday 13th December: Non-uniform day
