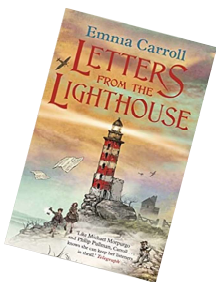

Key Learning this term...

Literacy: This half term we will be expanding our writing styles to include a narrative, radio scripts and persuasive letters. Our poem this term is the powerful 'Woman Work' by Maya Angelou.

Maths: we continue to work on multiplication, division and fractions and start to look at shape. Please encourage children to practice their times-tables regularly to help with these areas of Maths.

Science: This term we revisit the states of matter from year 4 but focus on their changing state.

Art: we will create portraits and use a variety of materials and composition for the backgrounds

PSHE: We will explore what it is to be us.
