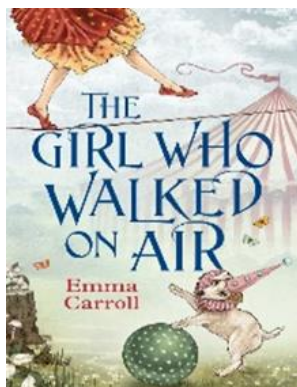




Newsletter Year 5/6 Autumn Term 2023

Key Learning this term...

Homework: Our homework will be set on a Wednesday and then marked the following Wednesday.

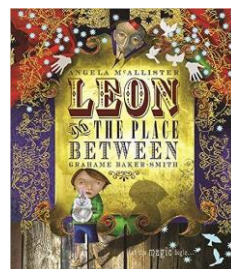
Swimming will be every Wednesday afternoon from 20th September.
